

Rules and By-Laws of Dukeries Motor Club Ltd

All members will abide by the rules and by-laws of the club as contained within the Memorandum and Articles of Association of Dukeries Motor Club Limited dated 5th June 1975, which the following is an extract.

Objectives of the Club

The Club is established for the purposes expressed in the Memorandum of Association which are briefly to promote, organise, finance and experiment in motor sport events for which the members of the Club and other club/associations under the general competition rules of the MSA or other recognised body. It will provide members with information, advice and assistance and afford them with all the usual privileges, advantages and accommodation of the Club.

Rules of Membership

- 1. Individual membership of the Club entitles the registered member only to the privileges, advantages and accommodation of the Club.**
- 2. Family membership of the Club entitles the registered member, his/her spouse and all children up to the age of 17 to the privileges, advantages and accommodation of the Club.**
- 3. Each registered member shall be entitled to ONE vote at all General Meetings of the Club.**
- 4. Any person who is NOT a fully registered (paid up) member of the Club shall not be eligible to hold office as a member of the Committee or vote at a General Meeting of the Club (AGM/EGM).**
- 5. Every registered member undertakes to contribute to the assets of the Club. If upon winding up or dissolution of the Club, satisfaction of all debts and liabilities will be limited to a sum NOT exceeding £1.00.**
- 6. Any registered member Not renewing his/her membership within 1 month of the date of expiry of the membership will cease to be a registered member.**
- 7. All members shall sign a written consent to become a registered member whereby he/she agrees to be bound by the Rules and By-Laws contained within the Memorandum and Articles of Association.**
